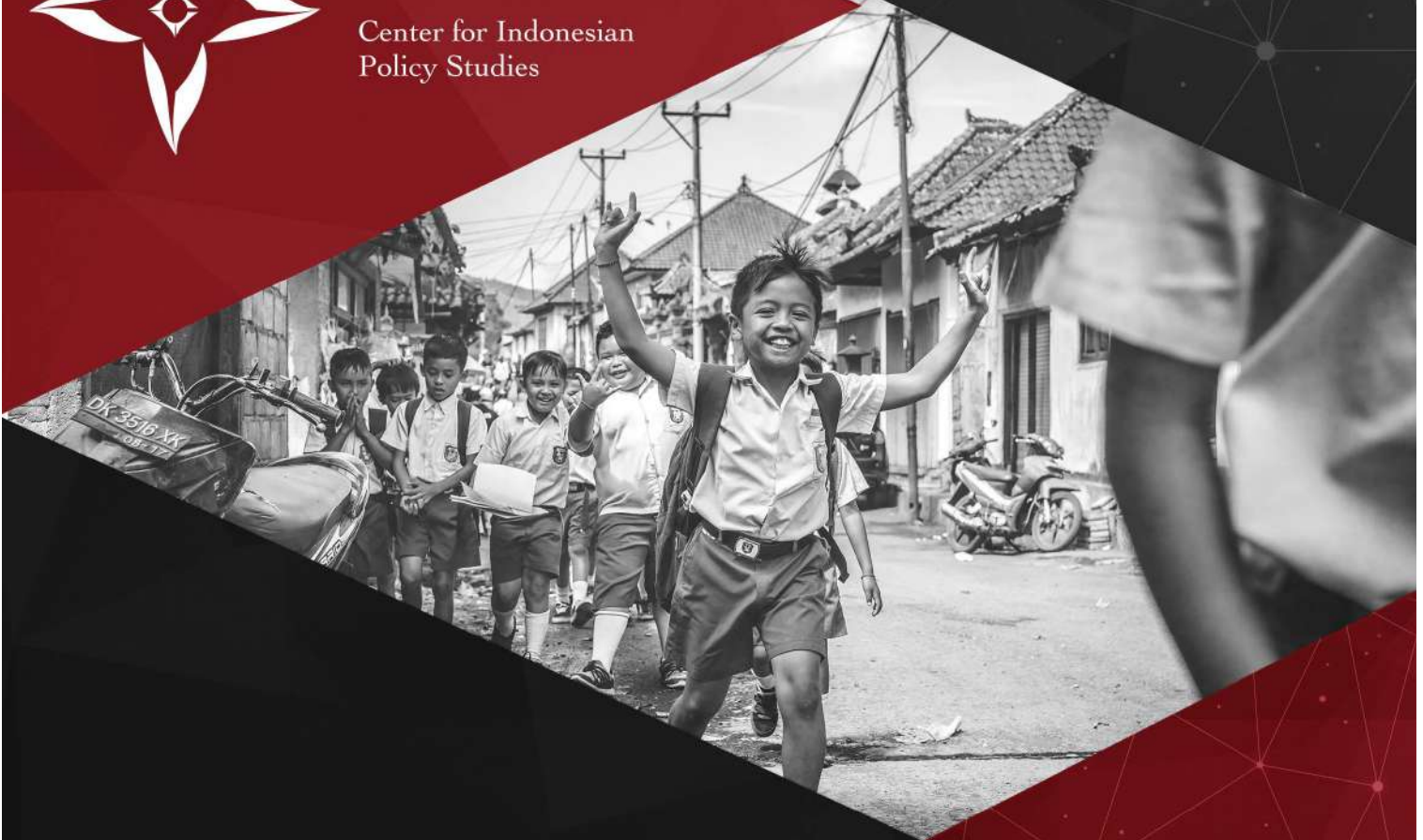

Research

The Research department is responsible for conducting studies, analysis, and reviews on government public policies. There are three focus area in research department, specifically Food Trade and Agriculture, Community Livelihoods, and Education.

The Research department works by identifying prospective research topics, conducting literature reviews, preparing the draft of policy papers, writing opinion articles and other types of publication, fulfilling the international academic standard, organizing meeting with the policymakers to advocate their research results, establishing partnerships with fellow researchers, academics, experts, and practitioners, and assisting in the fundraising efforts.

The department includes staff in the positions of Researchers and Junior Researchers.

External Relations

The External Relations department is responsible for overseeing CIPS' outreach to support policy advocacy efforts.

The external relations team work in building and cultivating relationships with media, institutional partners, and donors, building strong presence on website, social media and media channels, campaign strategy and management, and creating engaging content to convey policy messages and ideas to a range of audience stakeholders.

The department includes staff in the positions of Digital Manager, Institutional Relations Manager, Media Relations Manager, and Communications Officer.

Operations

Managing the flow of think tank daily operations, CIPS Operations Department handles the financial and administrative duties underpinning CIPS' projects as well as human resource and office management.

These include preparing and conducting programs and events, creating and maintaining documents related to human resource management and policy, internal task delegation and coordination, and organizing and managing the internship and volunteer program.

The team making up the Operations Department is CIPS General Manager, Finance and Administrative Officer, and Program and Activities Officer.

Akademi CIPS

Akademi CIPS is a part of Center for Indonesian Policy Studies (CIPS). Akademi CIPS provides Online Courses in Bahasa Indonesia to high school students and working adults about a broad range of topics ranging from life skills, social sciences to public policies and how they work to how to make responsible decisions.
